The steering brake kit fits the 5000 Series tractors only. The kit will not fit the 500 Series nor the 7.6 tractors.


The wheel brakes are designed to assist in steering the tractor and have a parking lock feature.

A Section 1

OPERATION

Read the tractors Operator's Manual and become familiar with the controls and their function before attempting to use the brakes.

Move the brake handlebar to the right to make the tractor turn to the left.

Move the brake handlebar to the left to make the tractor turn to the right. See fig. 2.

Do not use the brake when backing the tractor. Use the handlebars of the tractor for steering when backing.

PARKING

To engage the parking brake, stop tractor, disengage PTO, put the forward/reverse and high-lo gear in neutral. Pull parking brake lock lever back and up. See fig. 3.

To disengage the parking brake, push the parking brake lock lever down and forward. See fig. 4.

CLEANING THE BRAKES

Wash the brake assemblies with hose and water. Dirt will cause excessive wear on the brake linings and brake drums.

BRAKE ADJUSTMENT

1. Loosen the jam nuts on the right and left brake rods. See figs. 5 & 6.



2. Turn the adjusting nuts on the brake rods until the cross weldment is parallel to the instrument panel. The brake handlebar should have a slight amount of free movement to assure that the brakes are not too tight. See fig. 7.

- 3. After making the adjustments, check the free movement of the wheels by pushing or pulling the tractor with engine stopped and all controls in neutral. If either wheel drags, re-adjust.
- 4. If wheels move freely, move the brake handle bar to the right while pushing on the right handlebar of the tractor. This should activate the left wheel brake. If it does not, re-adjust.
- 5. Move the brake handlebar to the left while pulling on the right handlebar of the tractor. This should activate the right wheel brake. If it does not, re-adjust.
- 6. Engage the parking brake lock. Check to make sure both wheel brakes are engaging properly. If both brakes do not engage, re-adjust.
- 7. When brakes are properly adjusted, tighten the jam nuts against the adjusting nuts.



This Limited Warranty is issued by Clarke-Gravely Corporation, Gravely Division, and consists of the following terms:

- Only the original purchaser of new Gravely manufactured attachments is covered by this Warranty.
- This Warranty covers repair or replacement of parts manufactured by Gravely which are defective in material or workmanship. Gravely will pay for parts and labor only.
- The Warranty starts the date of purchase and lasts for NINETY (90) DAYS for attachments used in Roofer applications, and TWELVE (12) MONTHS for products used in all other applications.
- 4. Some components of Gravely attachments are not covered by the Gravely Warranty. These components are covered by the original manufacturer's warranty. They are:
 - (a) Tires Goodyear, Goodrich, Armstrong, General and Firestone
- To obtain warranty service on Gravely attachments including components not manufactured by Gravely, use this procedure:
 - (a) Notify the Gravely dealer from whom you purchased the attachment.
 - (b) If you have moved and it is not convenient to notify the selling dealer, notify the nearest Gravely dealer. You should supply this dealer with a copy of the bill of sale as proof of the date of purchase.
 - (c) Make arrangements to have the attachment delivered to the dealer (refer to paragraph 6(a) below).

(e) Warranty service on Gravely attachments must be performed by an authorized Gravely dealer or Gravely factory branch.

 - (a) Transportation between owner's home or place of business and the dealership. If the dealer provides the transportation of the attachment, he will charge the owner his usual rate for such service.
 - (b) Normal maintenance services and normal replacement of items such as belts lubricants, mower, plow or cultivator blades.
