NAME: STEERING BRAKE KIT AND REMOTE AIR CLEANER COMBINATION

SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

REMOTE AIR CLEANER PART NUMBER(S): 8 HP 21319 10 & 12 HP 21295 STEERING BRAKE KIT 23378

When the tractor is to be equipped with a remote air cleaner and a steering brake kit, the air cleaner canister assembly must be located on the brake handlebar weldment instead of the instrument panel. See figs. 1 & 2.

Tractor equipped with Remote Air Cleaner:

- Remove the air cleaner canister assembly from the "air cleaner to tractor bracket" (part No. 21234).
- Remove the "air cleaner to tractor bracket" (part No. 21234) from the instrument panel and discard the "air cleaner to tractor bracket" (part No. 21234).
- Install the steering brake kit according to the set-up instructions for the steering brake kit.
- After installing the steering brake kit attach the remote air cleaner canister assembly to the brake handlebar weldment with the muffler clamps (part No. 14728) as shown and located in figs. 1 & 2.
- Route the air cleaner hose on the outside of the handlebar and control rods of the tractor, making sure the hose clears the tractor control rods under any use situation.

Tractor without Remote Air Cleaner or Steering Brake Kit: (Installing both units.)

- If both the remote air cleaner kit and steering brake kit are to be installed, install the steering brake kit first according to the steering brake kit set-up instructions.
- After the steering brake kit has been installed, install the remote air cleaner kit according to the air cleaner kit instructions disregarding the instructions concerning mounting the air cleaner assembly on the instrument panel.
- Attach the remote air cleaner canister assembly to the brake handlebar weldment with the muffler clamps (part No. 14728) as shown and located in figs. 1 & 2. Route the air cleaner hose on the outside of the handlebar and control rods of the tractor, making sure the hose clears the tractor control rods under any use situation.
