Subject: G.M.T. Fuel Tank Fitting Torque

Recent reports of leaking fuel tanks on the G.M.T. have been traced to over tightening of the fitting in the bottom of the tank.

Proper torque for the fuel tank fitting is 8 to 10 footpounds. Excessive torque results in the rubber washer bowing and the tank leaking.
